The main difference between the X-PAC (large photo at top of page) and the N-PAC (photo immediately above) systems is that the X-PAC manages massive collections (up to 20,000 CDs worth) on its internal hard drives, while the N-PAC accesses Network Attached Storage (NAS) devices for multi-room use, as well as larger music collections.

The X-PAC combines an X100 Music Server/Player and X725 DAC/Stereo Amplifier, while the N-PAC combines an N100 Network Music Server/Player and the same X725 DAC/Stereo Amplifier. Just add a pair of high-quality stereo speakers to bring audiophile sound to your home, office, RV or boat.

Both the X-PAC and N-PAC systems feature Remote Internet Technical Support. Troubleshooting is simple because users can simply send a Remote Support Request using the Aurender Conductor app, allowing engineers to quickly diagnose and fix problems over the Internet, should they occur.
